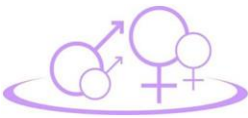

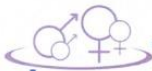

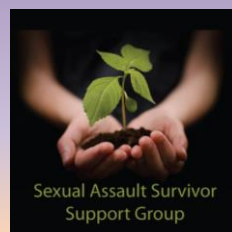
REGISTER for Technology of Participation (ToP) Facilitation Methods Course!

Wise Youth Group receives 3-year grant to kick-start the 2015-16 year!



Through diligent grant-writing efforts of WWGP, Wise Youth group will operate for the next 3-years with a focus on Sexual Assault Prevention in our community.

Wise Youth group, a program of WWGP, received a Rape Prevention Education grant through the Wisconsin Coalition Against Sexual Assault (WCASA) to support 24 High School Wise Youth (HSWY) meetings and 12 Middle School Wise Youth (MSWY) meetings.

The HSWY group was named a coalition of Native youth who will be leaders in the delivery of community education at MSWY meetings teaching them prevention tools through curriculums like Discovery Dating, Non-Violent Communication, Expect Respect and Native Wellness: Healthy Relationships.

Wise Youth continues to seek funds so that both groups can meet weekly throughout the school-year which is a total of 36 weeks each. Meeting weekly and growing our financial support would allow group members to address other youth-identified topics like bystander intervention, practicing for job interviews, healthy relationships, changing how we treat the earth and helping to improve our community.
