Wise Youth presents at 2016 State-wide Teen Summit on Heathy Relationships!



*"Love does not hurt,

16 Wise Youth members attended the 2016 Teen Summit in WI Dells on April 4-6, 2016 – a gathering of 400+ youth and adults focused on healthy teen relationships.

Teens were encouraged to share inspiring quotes they heard via social media with hashtags #TogetherTeensWill, #TeenSummitWI and #TeenViews. Wise Youth member Angalee Powless posted to FaceBook "Love does not hurt, Love does not call 37 times, Love is not Painful, Love does not isolate. That is a form of abuse" - a quote she heard from keynote speaker Samantha Collier.

Wise Youth members presented a dynamic lesson out of Discovery Dating, a curriculum written by founder of Wise Women Gathering Place, Alice Skenandore. More than 40 attendees participated in the interactive workshop! Participants had a chance to reflect on ways they would integrate the learnings about healthy relationships into their personal life. Workshop attendees were engaged and gave high praise to Wise Youth members on their performance!

Wise Youth members also courageously showcased their singing talent at Open Mic Night along with other teens from around the state. It was truly a beautiful moment when teens went running up to sing 'Love Yourself' by Justin Beiber as a group. It was a moment when all present realized the power of youth voice, youth togetherness and youth change!
